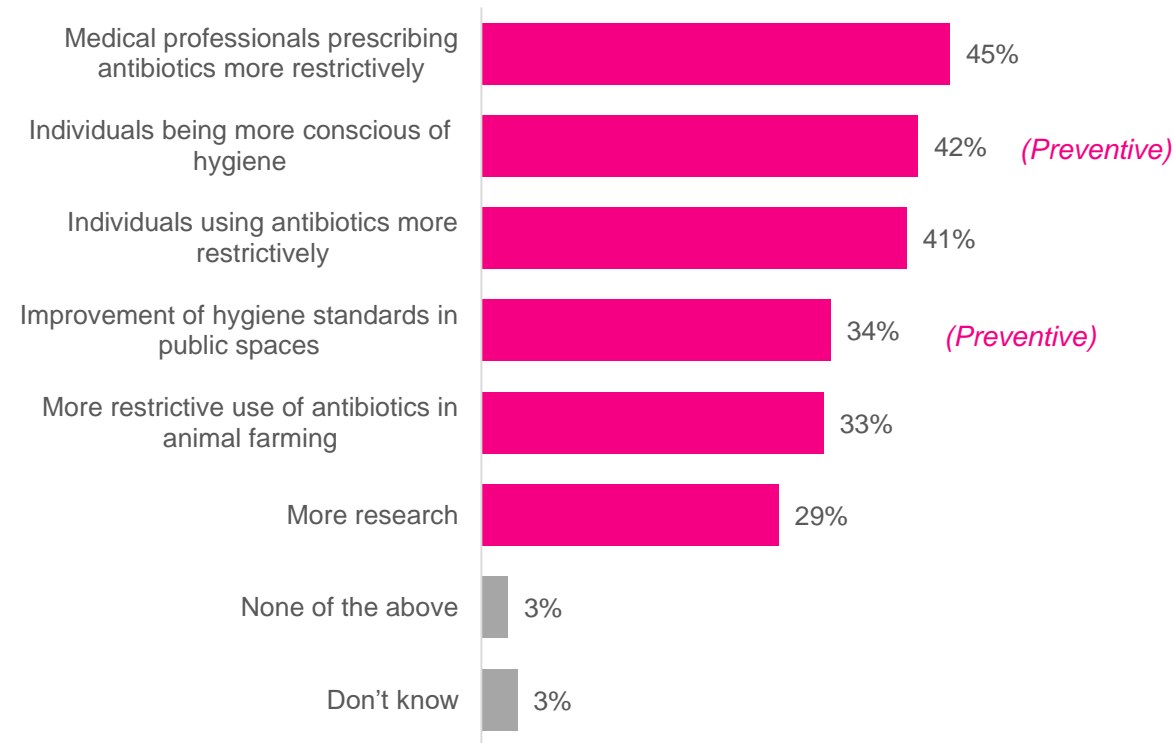


# ANTIBIOTICS RESISTANCE
